8 billion text messages are sent in the USA each month, and 4.5 billion in the UK.

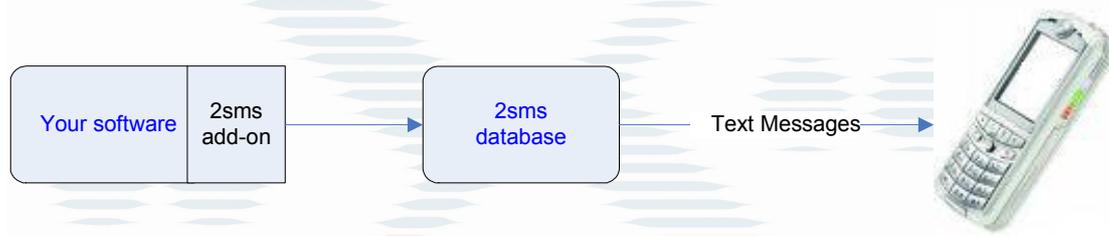
What are Text Messages Used For?

Text messages are used for two things :

- ✓ Personal communications, including leisure and entertainment. Typically this is handset to handset, or an interaction with a commercial entertainment service, e.g. TV voting.
- ✓ Business use, including Tech alerts, Internal Operations notices, Management information, Emergenc planning and operations, Field force management and customer service. Text messages are also used by some organisations for marketing purposes, although this is not an area that 2sms is involved in.

Why Would an Organisation use Text Messaging?

In one word: productivity.

What do our Customers use 2sms for?

2sms customers use text messaging for internal communications. Our customers recognise that:

 Internal operations	Organisations wishing to move people or

	Emergency management	<p>resources from one location to another send out a text message to alert, inform and instruct. People react faster, resources are reassigned quicker, and customers benefit from a more responsive organisation.</p> <p>In these troubling times, the safety of people has never been so important. How an organisation communicates in times of emergency is often overlooked. By using the 2sms 'Emergency planning' product, customers can setup distribution lists to allow rapid outbound communications, and also benefit from the ability of employees to text in their status to a central point. Knowing who is OK and who is missing allows more effective deployment of first Responders.</p>
	Customer service	<p>Organisations wishing to maintain relationships with customers find that 'service' messages, not 'marketing' messages, are valued by their customers. "Your car is ready for collection", "Your mortgage application has been accepted" are typical service messages. Sending a text to a customer with a 'Call us' call to action also speeds up customer service operations.</p>
	Field force management	<p>Where an organisation has people in the field, text messaging is a fast way to communicate internal information. Changes in stock levels, new pricing, Health and Safety information, changing schedules all benefit from the speed of text messaging.</p>
	Management Information	<p>2sms customers use text messaging to share information with key members of staff. Many 2sms customers send out Financial information shortly after it has been released to the stock exchange. 2sms customers trust 2sms to send out price sensitive and time critical information.</p>
	Duty of care	<p>Employers have a duty of care towards employees as well as customers. Notices of new legislation and reminders of existing rules all serve to educate and inform an organisation's stakeholders. Text messaging is used daily by 2sms customers for this purpose. 2sms provides an audit trail of communications sent out that can be accessed at a future date if proof of transmission is needed.</p>
	Recruiting / Resource management	<p>Organisations recruit people continuously. Getting information out to people who are applying for new positions can be done by phone, email or mail... and now Text Messaging. For internal or external recruitment, text messaging can get information about new positions out to candidates quickly. Appointments and changes to schedule can be confirmed via email. This is faster than calling.</p>

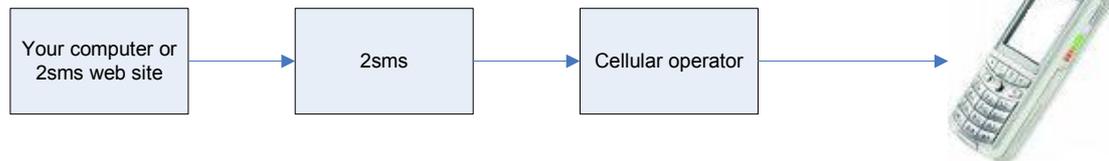

How does Text Messaging Work?

To send a text message, a customer needs to give 2sms two pieces of information.

1. The cell phone(s) you wish to send a text message.
2. The message you wish to send.

You can send a text message from the 2sms web site, or from your computer. If you use Microsoft Outlook or Excel, send from these applications with the free 2sms 'add-in' software.

If you have a database, we have a solution that will allow you to send text messages from your database to cell phones. (A ODBC compliant database is required)
